

**Minutes for June 26, 2017**  
**17th Precinct Community Council Meeting**

The meeting was called to order at 6:10 p.m. by Matt Roberts, president of the community council.

The minutes for the May 30, 2017, meeting were read and approved.

Running unopposed in a special election to fill the position of vice president of the community council, Tom Dougherty was confirmed as the new vice president.

**Vision Zero**

DI Papamichael reviewed the Vision Zero efforts undertaken by the precinct earlier in the month. During week 1, officers promoted awareness and educated the public by passing out flyers to bicyclists and motorists and visiting senior centers and schools to discuss safety points. During week 2, officers focused on ticketing around the Midtown Tunnel, issuing more than 350 summonses in that targeted area alone.

**Homeless**

The mayor's office is working on a joint plan with the Department of Homeless Services and other homeless agencies within the city to better address the needs of this segment of Manhattan's population.

**UN General Assembly**

The UN General Assembly will be held from September 12 to September 24, the first week being the busiest, with various street closings and traffic disruptions.

**JIC Tour**

A tour of the NYPD Joint Information Center at One Police Plaza is scheduled for the evening of Thursday, June 28, for all interested community members.
